The Honorary Colorado Life Membership Award is the highest honor that can be bestowed upon an individual, with recommendation by a local unit, council or state of directors. It is an especially significant way to honor worthy people in your school or community.

Recipients are individuals – not groups or couples – whom a PTA/PTSA wishes to honor for outstanding contributions to the welfare of children and youth or for support shown the PTA/PTSA organization. The honoree need not be a member of the PTA/PTSA, nor be well known beyond his or her own area of service. Honorary Life Members are invited to special Colorado activities and recognized at functions like the Colorado PTA annual convention.

To award an individual an Honorary Colorado Life Membership, please fill out the form below and mail it with a check for fifty dollars (\$50), payable to Colorado PTA. A pin is also available for fifteen dollars (\$15).

**Note:** For a recipient to obtain active membership status in Colorado PTA (and such voting privileges that accompany such membership) the individual must submit local / cameo unit membership dues annually.
