

RESOLUTION

(Adopted by the 1986 convention delegates)

PARENTS AND STUDENTS ON STATE ACCOUNTABILITY COMMITTEE

- WHEREAS, Parent representation is required by State Law to be included on district accountability/accreditation committees and not on the State Accountability Committee; and
- WHEREAS, Colorado Department of Education Rules and Regulations for Accountability/Accreditation name parents as one of the specified groups to be included in conducting needs assessments; and
- WHEREAS, The Colorado PTA recommended a motion that was approved by the State Accountability Committee to recommend that the State Board of Education seek legislation to add three parent and three student members to the State Accountability Committee; therefore be it further
- Resolved, That the Colorado PTA encourage the State Board of Education to include membership of three parents and three students on the State Accountability Committee in its legislative platform; and be it further
- Resolved, That the Colorado PTA seek legislative action to include three parents and three students as members of the State Accountability Committee.
