

PUBLIC SCHOOL FINANCE

WHEREAS, Adequate funding for public education is a fundamental responsibility of the state; and

WHEREAS, In 1982 the Colorado State Legislature made a statutory commitment to increase the 1984 Authorized Revenue Base by \$175 per student over the 1983 A.R.B.; therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Colorado PTSA, meeting in convention, urges the Colorado State Legislature to fulfill its statutory commitment to the \$175 per student increase in the 1984 Authorized Revenue Base; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Colorado State Legislature postpone major changes in the School Finance Act until its scheduled 1984 reauthorization process.
