

RESOLUTION

(Adopted by the 1963 Convention delegates)

Commendation of Loyal PTA Members

WHEREAS: during these periods of crisis, great mobility of population, threats to national and family security, re-examination of our aims, goals, and objectives there are attacks upon, harassments, and heckling of free public schools, school boards, administrators, teachers, and parent teacher associations; and

WHEREAS: the established institutions of church, public schools, homes, and free enterprise are jeopardized by the encroachment of philosophies which prove to be menaces cloaking themselves under seeming respectability to orderly democratic processes; and

WHEREAS: in the face of these attacks many courageous people seeking to maintain and strengthen the free public schools have remained steadfast and loyal to their goals and ideals; therefore

RESOLVED: that the Colorado Congress of Parents and Teachers commend these individual members, locals, and councils which have fought to maintain their integrity, uphold their dignity and remain steadfast in their sincere concerns for the welfare of children and youth.
