

RESOLUTION

(Adopted by the 1984 convention delegates)

NUCLEAR EDUCATION

WHEREAS, The health and welfare of children and youth is directly affected by their perceptions of hope for the future; and

WHEREAS, There are strong indications that young people are aware of the danger and threat of nuclear developments, and may consequently be questioning what future exists for them; and

WHEREAS, Young people's confusion and need for information constitute a serious call to parents and educators; and

WHEREAS, Young people need opportunities to learn about nuclear issues so that they may deal with their concerns and develop a factual understanding of these issues; therefore be it

Resolved, That the National PTA lend its full and active support to the identification of school nuclear education programs which will enable our young people to respond to the realities of nuclear developments with accurate information, critical thinking, and full ethical considerations.
