

WORKSHOP: STUDENTS EVALUATE TEACHERS

WHEREAS, The Colorado Congress of PTSA has recognized the student's partnership role with parents and teachers; and

WHEREAS, The Colorado Congress of PTSA believes that a voluntary system of appraisal of teachers by secondary school students would help improve classroom instruction, as well as provide positive feedback for successful teachers; and

WHEREAS, Such a system, to be effective, must be solely between teacher and student; and

WHEREAS, Students in attendance at the 1979 Colorado Congress of PTSA State Convention have requested the assistance of the State PTSA in pursuing their concept; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the President of the Colorado Congress of PTSA appoint a Special Committee consisting of students, teachers, parents and school administrators to develop and implement a pilot project designed to demonstrate a process for the appraisal of teachers by their students.
