COMPETENCY TESTING

- WHEREAS, The people are voicing the importance that a means be found to determine where the education process is effective; and
- WHEREAS, Upon completion of their education a student should be able to function and survive in today's world; and
- WHEREAS, Education holds a high priority in our world today; and
- WHEREAS, People are beginning to look at competence levels of students; therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That the Colorado Congress of PTSA will encourage all people to continue to be sensitive to the differences of all children, and emphasize the need not to try to mold children all into the same form; and be it further
- RESOLVED, That the Colorado Congress of PTSA sponsor a conference to explore competency testing and all the alternatives, so that parents, teachers, students and administrators will be more aware of any implications in legislative action or local school board policies that will be affecting the future lives of students in this area.
