Here are some ideas for advocacy activities that you can do in 2018:

- Host or attend an Advocacy Training for PTA members in your local unit, Council, or Region.
- Get up-to-date information about efforts to improve school funding by visiting the website of <u>Great Education Colorado</u> and signing up for updates. Register to attend their <u>Advocacy U</u> sessions and <u>Brown Bag Luncheons</u>.
- Attend the 2018 Action Summit on February 28, 2018.
- Sign up to carry a petition for the ballot initiative to create more school funding that will be coming out soon.
- Get information about state finance issues by visiting the website of the <u>Colorado Fiscal Institute</u> in particular, look at the Video Library under the Library tab, especially "Colorado State Budget and Taxes Explained."
- Attend <u>Speak Up for Kids Day</u> on March 14, 2018. Information about this event will be available soon.
- Host or attend an Advocacy Day for PTA members in your Council or Region either at the Capitol or at a location within the Council or Region. This could include meeting with local legislators and discussing PTA's legislative priorities and/or positions on specific bills. It could be done in conjunction with Advocacy Training.
- Attend your local legislator's Day at the Capitol, if one is held, and use it to advocate for PTA's legislative priorities and/or positions on specific bills.
